RED WINES

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Grown predominately in the Southwest region of France this noble varietal is rich in color, aroma and depth. Included among its many complexities are cedar, black currant and violets.



CABERNET FRANC

This varietal is grown throughout the Southwest regions of France. It is similar in many respects to the Cabernet Sauvignon but produces a less fruity and more earthy wine, which is highly aromatic.



CABERNET SYRAH

A delightful blend that gives this wine the best characteristics from two class varietals. The end result is an aromatic rich ruby color with fruit flavours and tannic overtones.



DOMAINE CHARMANT

The blend of "Gamay Noir" and "Cabernet Franc" results in an attractive ruby red wine which will delight you with its well-balanced bouquet of fresh ripe fruits, strawberries and raspberries. A typically light, fresh and fruity red wine made for sharing on any occasion.



GRENACHE

This varietal is grown in the south of France. It tends to produce a rich, warm, full-bodied wine with hints of berry aromas.



GAMAY

A famous grape varietal traditionally grown in the lush valleys of North-western France This grape is often used in the production of "Vin Nouveau". This fine wine has a dark rich color and it is light and fruity. Best consumed while fresh and young.



MERLOT

The Merlot varietal produces a ruby coloured red wine with a soft fruitiness and a rich velvet quality. An invaluable grape with great character for French wine producers.



French wines are considered to be among the world's best. The key to the success of French wines is the range of climates and soils in the various wine regions. This range is so great, the French have been able to use the best of each region to produce specific grapes that give the wines of each region their distinctive characteristics.

Since our FC Collection is made from grape juice and grape concentrates that come from France, you can expect some of the same characteristics that you will enjoy in a French wine.

RED WINES

PINOT NOIR GRANDE CUVÉE

This wine has a rich, almost seductive flavour of black cherries, spices and raspberries. Pinot Noir wine is rich but not heavy, medium to full-bodied, with substantial flavours despite its delicateness.



ROUGE CONVIVIAL

This wine gem is made from a blend of grapes, often including the Pinot Noir, that results in a medium-bodied, fruity wine with a distinct taste of red and black currants.



ROUGE DE CONCILIATION

This wine is a blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Grenache and boasts a splendid color: concentrated ruby red with gentle purple nuances. The nose is full and aristocratic, full of ripe red fruit, mint, tobacco, cacao and great mineral accents. Well balanced, with a velvety tannic richness, mighty, graceful, with a very long persistence. Sip it in an intimate atmosphere – superb with roasted turkey.



SAINT-EMILE

This wine is a blend of Merlot and Cabernet Franc and has a very deep red color of great consistence. Hints of berries and very aromatic. Well balanced, oaky with a pleasant body. A perfect red wine for those who usually only drink white wines. Dare to try something new! Enjoy with the best cut of Angus beef you can find.



SYRAH

This varietal known in some parts of the world as Shiraz, it is believed to have originated in Persia as far back as 600 BC. Now grown in Northern France, it produces a rich, tannic wine with intense fruit berry flavours and aromas.



RED WINES

VVDCR

This wine is produced from a blend of several varietals, two of the most common being Syrah and Grenache. Traditionally this wine is blended with up to as many as 13 different varietals. A dry, mellow wine, which is fruity with a rich color.



VVDCR/ MERLOT

One of the more elegant and sophisticated marriages ever made! The color is a full ruby red, lively with purple shades. Impressive to the nose, starting with balsamic hints on a pulpy red fruit background, closing with intriguing vanilla, cacao, and licorice notes. Great body, important and splendid tannins, long and velvet persistence. What more can you ask for?



BLUSH WINES

CARIGNAN BLUSH

Its Spanish origin is still remarkable whether grown in California or France. This blush is luminous to the nose, it arrives refined, with wild rose and raspberry nuances and a buttery feature. Warm and silky in the mouth, quite balanced, and of medium persistence. Suggested accompaniments, vegetable dishes and white meat – delightful with rabbit.



MOURVEDRE BLUSH

Though best known today for its presence in Southern France, Mourvedre is thought to have originated in Spain's Catalonia region. Persuasive bouquet with remarkable berries such as black currant, blackberry and elderberry, wild roses and tamarind, with silky and equilibrated freshness. Delicate, but so satisfactory to be self-sufficient, to the taste.



WHITE WINES

BLANC CONVIVIAL

Traditionally this blended wine uses varietals such as Chardonnay and Pinot Blanc. It produces a dry, medium-bodied wine with a delightful fruity taste and aroma.



BLANC DE CONCILIATION

Both Viognier and Chenin Blanc, used in the production of this elegant white wine, share a tropical fruit flavour with exotic scents. Typically golden in color, this medium to full-bodied wine has a very distinctive fruit character and intense aromas. A wine to be consumed young or moderately aged.



BLANC DE SAINT - REMY

With a golden brilliance and camomile and lavender, this blend of Pinot Blanc and Semillon, has nuances that remind us of saffron and cedar out from the Central Massif Mountains. Balanced in the mouth, extremely smooth and full-bodied. A must try for those who normally claim that they don't drink white wine because they prefer their wine with body. To be enjoyed with extraordinary seafood dishes.



BLANC DE SAINT - VINCENT

This unique blend of Pinot Gris and Sauvignon Blanc grapes creates a luscious dry white wine with a golden color and hints of tropical fruits. A rich, fairly full-bodied and slightly high in acidity wine. Best consumed young.



CHARDONNAY

This varietal is considered the greatest dry white wine grape in the world and is one of the major grapes used in the production of traditional sparkling wines. Golden white color, leaving a crisp clean taste on the palate. A classic, which is slightly fruity with hints of floral aromas.



WHITE WINES

CHALIZETTE

This wine is a blend traditionally produced with Chardonnay grapes. A light-bodied, earthy wine, which is dry, buttery with nutty hints.



CHATEAU SAINTE - ANNE

An exotic dress for this Chardonnay-based wine. The color is a lively pale yellow with gold nuances. It offers a wide range of scents: tropical fruit such as mango, pineapple, together with honey and white flowers. Structured, creamy, smooth in the taste, very long persistence with a fruit remembrance. Incredible with onion soup as well as red snapper.



COLOMBARD

Although traditionally a French grown varietal from the south west, this grape is now often found in California and South Africa. This youthful wine is light and slightly acid with fresh fruity bouquet and crisp clean flavour.



PINOT GRIS

This white wine is produced from the grape varietal with red skins that are not used during the production. In some parts of the world the skins would be used, resulting in a blush coloured wine. A succulent, rich, complex wine with spiciness that makes it unique.



SAUVIGNON BLANC

This French grown varietal is a popular grape which produces an aromatic, fruity and dry wine which possesses great character.



SEMILLON CHARDONNAY

This blend of two popular varietals create a succulent, dry white wine with golden color. Crisp and clean on the palate with hints of tropical fruit and subtle floral aromas.
