RED WINES

AUSTRALIAN CABERNET SHIRAZ

Our Cabernet Shiraz brings you some of our best offerings! This blend delivers intense berry notes which is the trade mark of this prized varietal blending. It is rich, deep red in color featuring plum, raspberry and cherry notes with subtle herbs, spices and oak in the finish. Aging of 6 months is recommended.



AUSTRALIAN PINOT NOIR

Known as the "Heartbreak Grape" due to the fact that it is difficult to grow. Pinot Noir bouquet captures aromas of gentle vanilla and hints of red fruits, opening on notes of sweet liquorices and ending with a spicy remembrance. The taste is full and round, with a good acidity sustained by soft tannins. Optimum with goat cheese, salami, duck or ham.



AUSTRALIAN SHIRAZ

This wine is a favorite of the Aussies and likely to become your favorite too. Highly tannic with intense berry flavors. Aging will increase the complexity and optimize the characteristics of this wine. Aging of 6 months is recommended.



CHILEAN CABERNET SAUVIGNON

This wine has a deep ruby/ bluish color, with sweet fruity perfumes of high complexity; the black cherry and mint notes are perfectly married with cacao and vanilla. Well balanced and dry for those who love trying different Cabernets. This one enjoys the benefits of the perfect sunny and hot climate of the Central Valley! Unforgettable with grilled red meat and lamb.



CHILEAN MERLOT

It is no longer confused with Carmenere and represents one of the grapes that Chileans are focusing on to gain success in the international wine market. Deep ruby red color with violet nuances. The nose suggests liquorices, and red ripe fruits. Equilibrated in structure, however pulpy and rich in taste. A beautiful way to extend dinner.



EUROPEAN CABERNET/MERLOT

Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon make an excellent union of grapes. Merlot is light in tannin and produces a smoother and softer wine, which evolves quicker than single varietal Cabernet Sauvignon wines. This wine has become very popular in the past few years and is recommended as a must try. Serve with pasta, meats and cheeses; it's also great with charbroiled steak! Aging of 6 months is recommended.



RED WINES

EUROPEAN CABERNET SAUVIGNON

This brilliant ruby red wine has a complex aroma with hints of red currants, field berries and subtle spices. You will find these same elements balanced with tannins in its flavour. This dry wine is excellent young, however, it benefits from a few months aging. Aging of 6 months is recommended.



EUROPEAN MARJOLAIS

A dry, fruity wine of excellent character. Its rich flavor and aroma marry earthy tones with plum and fruit flavors. Excellent young, its character develops quickly with a few months aging.



EUROPEAN MERLOT

Merlot has become one of the world's most popular red wines. It is a grape variety that is very much appreciated. This Merlot shows hints of many berries and will produce a rich full-bodied and smooth wine. Merlot is a great wine that will evolve slightly quicker than other varieties. Merlot is great for everyday entertaining, but also serves well for special occasions. Aging of 6 months is recommended.



EUROPEAN PINOT NOIR

Prized by wineries in Burgundy, France, this grape produces a superbly balanced wine of excellent character. Its flavor and aroma give off hints of mixed berries, medium tannin and earthy notes. It is brilliant clear red in color and medium-dry. Most pleasant young but aging of 6 months is recommended. This medal winning wine is great with red meats but it also serves well with poultry, try it for Thanksgiving dinner.



EUROPEAN ROUGE CONVIVAL

This smooth full-bodied French style wine is very versatile and can be ready to drink with minimal aging, but develops a better texture and bouquet with age. This is another great wine that can be served with various types of meat and cheese but is also a great everyday table wine!



EUROPEAN VERTUEUX ROUGE

This medium-bodied Burgundy style wine offers a bouquet that marries the flavours of ripe raspberries and black cherries. Dry with light tannins, this wine's deep red color shows glints of mahogany. Vertueux Rouge requires some aging of 6 months is recommended. An excellent choice for pizza night!



RED WINES

EUROPEAN VERVEUX ROUGE

This wine made with Cabernet Sauvignon and Syrah surely is not second to the most popular styles with its deep red color leaning on burgundy. Noticeable blackberry scents with a vanilla ending. The taste is tannic, fresh, with an enjoyable smoothness. Persistent with a spicy remembrance. Very good choice with home-made rabbit or strong cheese.



EUROPEAN VVCDR

This wine can be produced with a blend of as many as 13 grape varietals like Syrah, Carignan and Pinot Noir. The finished wine of this popular style is a dark red wine, hearty with spicy and powerful bouquet. Aging of 6 months is recommended.



ITALIAN BAROLO

This Nebbiolo based red wine with a brilliant red color is the height of Italian red wines. Barolo engulfs raspberry and truffle aromas. This powerful wine is highly tannic, full-bodied, and absolutely age worthy, offering deep flavors to the palate. This well-balanced wine can be served alone or with any hearty meat or pasta dishes. Aging of 6 months is recommended.



ITALIAN CHIANTI STYLE

This well-balanced classic Italian red wine is very popular. Full-bodied with ruby red color and powerful aromas. Full in the mouth when it's young, this wine definitely improves with age. Best aged for 6 months, so show some will-power and save a few bottles in the cellar.



ITALIAN LAMBRUSCO

Brilliant ruby red color with violet nuances. A nose of matured red fruit, with floral touches. Medium-bodied, smooth and fresh with a medium persistence in the mouth. Just right with home made fettuccini or spaghetti bolognese, salami, and pork.



ITALIAN MONTEPULCIANO

Montepulciano is one of the best wines Italy has to offer. This wine is dark and rich in color, dry, tannic and deeply perfumed with an excellent full-body. It has a robust bouquet, but let it age and it will grow to become an irresistible wine that will be a definite favorite. Best served with Italian fare or let your culinary skills create a dish to enjoy it with.

Your local Italian friend may call this wine Pinot Grigio, but in France they call it Pinot Gris! A tasteful, low acid wine with a slight rosé hue. It is traditionally known that the best Pinot Grigio wines are produced in the northeast of Italy. Best enjoyed young.



CHILEAN SHIRAZ ROSE

Three words to describe a unique marriage to savour. Lovely full blush colour, very luminous. The bouquet offers a wide series of intense perfumes from red roses to wild strawberries, ending with an intriguing trace of medlar. Its easy structure and freshness give the right balance to make this wine very palatable with a pleasant floral persistence. Perfect with your favourite appetizers.



CALIFORNIAN WHITE ZINFANDEL

Unlike it's name, this wine is not white but has a slightly pink hue; lighter than the Zinfandel Blush. It has a fruity, floral bouquet. Perfect for casual drinking. Best chilled before serving.



CALIFORNIAN ZINFANDEL BLUSH

This North American wine is a hit among folks who enjoy a slightly blush, fruity wine. Best chilled before serving.

WHITE WINES

AUSTRALIAN CHARDONNAY

This charming wine offers a dry and full mouth feel, illustrious color, low acidity, delicate and exuberant aromas. Australian Chardonnays are well appreciated when young but they are also age worthy wines.



CALIFORNIAN CHARDONNAY

This classic white grape varietal is also known as Pinot Chardonnay. It is a subtle and ample wine with recognizable hints of fruit and vanilla aromas. It has good suppleness and has great mouth-feel. Chardonnay is suitable for moderate aging.



EUROPEAN BLANC CONVIVIAL

It is a well balanced, dry and smooth wine. This Blanc Convivial takes after the popular French Burgundy wine with its traditional freshness. Perfect sipping wine for all occasions, from a summer barbeque to an elegant dinner party.



EUROPEAN CHALIZETTE

This is a very popular white wine style that's dry; light and has an austere mouth-feel. It is an excellent everyday table wine that is best when served young.



EUROPEAN L'OR BLANC

This white dry wine is produced to bare a resemblance to the world's famous Pouilly Fuissé. Produced with Chardonnay grapes, this wine has a perfume of tropical fruits. Like most good white wines, it's best served young with mild aging.



EUROPEAN MOSCADEL BIANCO

A bright yellow color for this unique wine made primarily from a blend of Muscat and Chenin Blanc. Persistent and rich aromas modulated on hints of exotic fruit seasoned with a touch of honey. A warm and enveloping taste that confirms the fruit remembrance. Try with your favorite dessert.



EUROPEAN SAUVIGNON BLANC

This aromatic white grape variety is widely cultivated in France, Italy and California. This wine is fresh and rich in acidity; our suggestion is that it should be consumed young.



EUROPEAN SEMILLON/ CHARDONNAY

The blending of the Semillon and Chardonnay varietals is a most interesting skill. Thanks to the excellent marriage between these two grapes the outcome is smooth, herbaceous and shows slight acidity. When this harmonious blend is aged, the wine will grow to be rich with intense flavors.



WHITE WINES

EUROPEAN VERTUEUX BLANC

Vertueux Blanc is produced to have similarities with white Bordeaux type wines. This wine comes from a blending of several white varietals which produces a fruity wine ready to be consumed young.



EUROPEAN VERVEUX BLANC

A deep pale and bright colour. This wine, made from Sauvignon Blanc and Chenin Blanc, has an exciting and wide smelling profile: a mineral scent mixed with sensations of aromatic herbs, elderberry flowers and honeysuckle. In the mouth, it is complex, offering sustained freshness and vivid taste leading to a perfect smoothness. Its mineral persistence shows clearly how sophisticated this wine is. An ideal choice for seafood dishes.



GERMAN GEWURZTRAMINER

This is a variety with particularly intense aromas of the old seedling "Traminer". Originating from the Pfalz region in Germany, this type of grape produces a strong and full-bodied wine that is mellow, spicy and highly aromatic. (Gewurz means spice in German).



GERMAN LIEBFRAUMLICH

Rheinhessen is the Liebfraumilch native soil. It's delicate perfumes and pleasant body are the main characteristics of this fruity and mellow wine. This is an excellent wine to be served with seafood and it's best to drink when young.



GERMAN PIESPORTER

Originating from the Moselle-Saare-Ruwer region, this wine is fruity and cleverly balanced with a bit of acidity that reminds us of citrus fruit aromas. Best served very cold.



GERMAN RIESLING

This is the classic German grape varietal. Subtle, fruity and perfumed. Riesling can stand up to any Chardonnay as one of the world's best white wines. Slightly acidic, it's best served young.



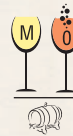
GERMAN SYLVANER

A brilliant pale yellow color with a very elegant nose, reminding us of exotic fruits, intense florals, and a lovely green nuance. Harmonious, good body, smooth and with a pleasant aromatic persistence to the palate. Ideal with fish, shellfish, vegetarian pasta and goat cheese.



ITALIAN FRASCATI

Traditionally produced north of lake Albano, Southeast of Rome, it is a golden white wine based on a blend of Trebbiano and Malvasia grapes. Growing in popularity Frascati is a mellow wine which is smooth in the mouth. This excellent wine should be enjoyed young. Excellent with seafood and light cream sauces.



WHITE WINES

ITALIAN SOAVE STYLE

Soave means "melodious" and the choice of this name for a wine obtained by Garganega grapes is not by chance. Smooth fruity aromas that remind us of apricot, peach, pineapple and honey. Leaves the palate with a fresh acidity and good balance. Great with vegetarian pizza, fish, quiche or omelettes.



ITALIAN VERDICCHIO

The name is due to its greenish-yellow grape that is widely planted in the Macerata region in Italy. This crisp wine is pale, light-bodied and a bit acidic. This is also a great wine for producing sparkling "Champagne" style wines.



ITALIAN WHITE RESERVE

This premium wine is a well-kept proprietary secret blend of different grape varietals. Our winemaker at Advintage stresses how refreshing and pleasant this hidden treasure is. It's a must try for the discerning white wine drinker. Best served chilled and slightly aged.



NAPA RIESLING STYLE

The main characteristic of this Riesling is its extraordinary mineralogy together with apple and peach nuances and white flowers. To the taste it is full-bodied, balanced with a pleasant persistence. Perfect with sushi, seafood, poultry and vegetables.



NEW ZEALAND PINOT BLANC

Pale yellow in colour with faint gleams of green. This wine has tempting scents of field flowers, bread crust and golden apple together with hints of mineral notes. The balance is fully satisfied by its softness and the smell/taste coherence. It is pulpy with a long persistence and an almond ending. Excellent with seafood.



SOUTH AFRICAN CHENIN BLANC

Gentle pale yellow with gold shades. Elegant to the nose with a definite ripe apple scent, straw and elder flowers, and a mild white pepper touch. In the mouth its easy structure makes it round, fresh, palatable. A wonderful compliment to a meal of seafood, veal or poultry.

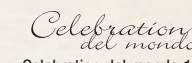

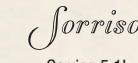
